YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL VISIT TO NORTH YORKSHIRE- 14th - 16th JULY 2025

Following the success of previous visits, we are delighted to inform you that this year's Year 6 residential visit will be to Scarborough and North Yorkshire in July 2025.

We will be staying at Scarborough Youth Hostel on a full board basis enjoying all the facilities the hostel has to offer. On Day 1 we travel to Eden Camp Modern History Museum at Malton to experience the sights and sounds of life on the Home Front and the Front Line. Later in the afternoon we will travel to Scarborough and check-in at our accommodation and enjoy our evening meal. After dinner, and weather permitting, we'll head to the beach for some fun and games!

After breakfast on Day 2 we will visit the National Railway Museum at York to explore the past, present and future of the railways. After lunch, we'll return to Scarborough to spend the afternoon at the Sealife Aquarium, meeting the residents of Penguin Island, Otter River, the Seal Hospital and a trek through the Rainforest Adventure.

On Day 3 we leave Scarborough and travel to Danby Lodge National Park Centre by the side of the beautiful River Esk for a River Discovery Day. We will observe river features and collect and identify freshwater invertebrates, look at adaptations and design an alien invertebrate adapted for a freshwater habitat to bring back to school and hopefully find some time to let off some steam in their adventure playground before the journey home to Blyton.

The cost of the visit is £230 per person, which includes all meals, travel, admission prices, workshops, and hostel facilities. If you would like your child to take part in this visit, we require a deposit of £20 by the 31st January. Due to a temporary issue with the SchoolPing payment feature, we kindly ask that the deposit be paid directly into the school bank account. Please refer to the next page for the bank details. We hope to have the payment system up and running for future instalments. You can also send in a cash payment with your permission slip.

For the rest of the payment, you can pay in instalments, with a monthly payment plan available at £42 due on the 1st of each month until July. The first instalment of £42 will be due on the 1st March.

Please note that once you have paid the deposit, your child's place will be secured, and cancellations will not be possible, as we will have already made a non-refundable payment for that place.

Unfortunately, if we do not receive sufficient interest and deposit payments for this visit, we will have no alternative but to cancel the trip and refund any deposits made.

We will hold an information evening later in the Spring Term where we will give further details regarding the itinerary and answer any questions you may have. Yours sincerely
