## Proper Nouns

Use proper nouns in your writing to be specific about the name of a person, animal or place.

Writer's tip:



Always use a capital letter at the start of a name.

Staring angrily, **Shere Khan**'s teeth were sharp knives pointing to the sky.



Hovering, the moon is a spaceship peering patiently down on **Earth**.

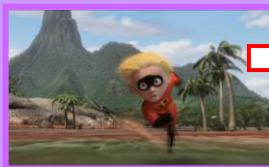
## Capital letters and full stops

Writer's tip:

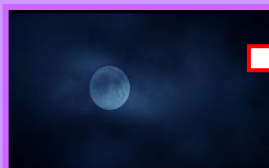


Don't forget to use capital letters for names of people, animals and places too!
