### WORLD BOOK DAY - THURSDAY 5<sup>TH</sup> MARCH

#### BCL BOOK SWAP SHOP

On World Book Day we are going to host a BcL book swap shop. This will look different at Blyton and Laughton. Please see below for information.

#### **KS1** BcL Book Swap Shop

The idea is that your child brings in one or two books from home (good condition) that they no longer read and then can choose a new one to bring home.

Children can bring in a voluntary donation of £1. All funds raised will be spent on new books for the school library.

We invite you to join the children in their book swap and to have refreshments alongside some book themed activities from 2:15 - 3:00pm at the Laughton site. (KS1 children only)

#### **KS2** BcL Book Swap Shop

Second hand books (including many from Mr Duke's shelves) will be sold for between 20p and £2. Children can buy more than one book if they wish and may donate books from home for the shop. Any donations can be delivered prior to the day to Mr Duke's office.

Any child wishing to buy a book can bring money on the day. Money raised from the book shop will buy new books for the school library.
