### ABSENCE PROCEDURE

If a child is absent or arrives late to school, we follow a set procedure to ensure that all children are accounted for.

If a child is absent and we have not been informed of a reason, we will send a message via Arbor. If we are still unable to confirm the reason, as part of our safeguarding procedures, a member of the office team will begin contacting the emergency contacts listed on your child's file until we have confirmation of their absence.

To help us keep our registers up to date, we ask that parent/carers let us know as soon as possible if their child will be absent or late.
